How to find Glenfield Hospital

Public Transport

The bus routes servicing the Hospital are the 27, 27A, 14A, 28, 54, 70A and UHL bus. The Hospital shuttle bus departs from outside Leicester National Rail train station every 30 minutes from 7.00am - 6.30pm, Monday to Friday. Catch it at the bus stops listing UHL as one of the services that stop there to travel to Glenfield Hospital, Leicester General Hospital and Leicester Royal Infirmary. All journeys cost £1.50.

The nearest National Rail train station is Leicester, located on London Road, near to the centre of the city. For timetables and ticket sales contact National Rail Enquiries on 08457 48 49 50 or text 0845 60 50 600.

Car Parking

Northbound - Exit M1 J21A onto A46. Turn onto A50 for Glenfield and follow the signs for Glenfield Hospital.

Southbound - Exit M1 J22 onto A50 towards Glenfield & Glenfield Hospital.

Car Parking is Pay and Display and the daily charge for parking at the hospital is £5.50.
