Public Transport

Bus routes serving the hospital include Konect 9, First 12, First 21/22, First 24, Konect 3 and Konect 4. For public transport enquiries call 0871 200 22 33 (08:00-20:00, daily) or visit www.traveline.org.uk

National Express provide services between London Liverpool Street, Colchester, Ipswich and Norwich as well as local services starting and finishing in Norwich and Ipswich including all stations to Great Yarmouth, Lowestoft, Sheringham, Felixstowe, Cambridge and Peterborough and services to Harwich International.

From Norwich railway station, our advice is to use a taxi to get to the hospital, which is a 20 minute journey across the city.

Car Parking

There are a total of 850 parking spaces for patients and visitors at the hospital. Car parks N & O are closest to the scanner. All of the car parks have disabled spaces. Disabled parking is free but you will need to take your blue badge to reception to have your car parking ticket validated.
