How to find Lincoln County Hospital

Lincoln County Hospital,
Greetwell Road, Lincoln, Lincolnshire LN2 5QY

By Road

Lincoln County Hospital is on the eastern edge of north-east Lincoln and is signposted from most routes into Lincoln. When entering the site - the scanner is best accessed via St. Anne's Road & then Sewell Road, via entrance B and patients are advised to be dropped off by the scanner.

Public Transport

By bus - There are regular buses that serve the hospital on Route 4 from Lincoln city Bus Station. Please visit the Stagecoach website for more information www.stagecoachbus.com/lincolncityRM.aspx. Bus timetables can be obtained from Lincolnshire County Council.

By rail - if you are coming to Lincoln County Hospital by train and would like assistance in planning your journey, you may wish to use the www.nationalrail.co.uk. The nearest train station is Lincoln Central Station.

Car Parking

Patient car parking at Lincoln County Hospital costs £1.40 for 0-1 hours, £3.40 for 1-4 hours and £4 for over 4 hours.

A daily charge of £1.50 per day will be implemented for Blue Badge holders.
