Public Transport

Royal Liverpool University Hospital is well served by public transport. Patients and visitors who are able to do so may wish to consider using public transport. For details of routes, services and times please contact the Merseytravel line on 0151 236 7676.

Car Parking

Patients and visitors can park in the nearby secure Q-Park facility which is situated less than a 5 minute walk from the Hospital and is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The vehicle entrance to Q-Park is on Epworth Street (off Erskine Street) and to access this, you must follow the signposts through the one way system onto Epworth Street. A pedestrian exit is available on the Prescott Road side of the car park.

Please take your ticket with you when you leave your car. Payment is made when you return to your car at the machines within the car park. Your ticket is inserted into the exit barrier as you leave the car park.

Disabled Parking & Shuttle Bus Facility

Disabled car parking is provided at the Q-Park multi-storey. Disabled spaces are available on the first level and are well marked and signposted. Staff are available to provide assistance to patients and visitors as required.

A shuttle bus service runs between Q-Park and the Hospital buildings to provide transport assistance to anyone requiring it. The bus runs on request so if the bus is not there as you arrive, please speak to security or car park staff who will radio for the bus to pick you up within a few minutes.
